All of us in industry are aware of the importance of vocational training and it has been one of the great concerns of the members of GERMAN INDUSTRY UK for a long time: Too many (short term) programmes not any long term solution in the UK unlike Germany which has a long established dual vocational training system.

We started a dialogue with the Department for Innovation, Universities and Skills some two years ago and discussed our concerns with the Minister for Skills Mr David Lammy MP over dinner in October 2007 (www.gi-uk.co.uk/events2007) followed by a survey amongst German companies in the UK in November 2007 ([click here to download the survey](#)).

In the summer of 2008 Mr Bob Bischof and Dr Bernd Atenstaedt accompanied the Minister to Berlin and Düsseldorf for talks with the German government, employers and unions and visits to training facilities of Mercedes-Benz and Henkel.

Mr David Lammy MP was promoted Minister of State later in 2008 and we continued our dialogue with the new **Minister for Skills Lord Tony Young of Norwood Green** over dinner in March 2009.
