## **`Brexit in Crisis`**

MPs rejected the Prime Minister's Brexit deal for a second time on Tuesday after their first rejection on 15 January. They voted against the prospect of the UK leaving the EU without a deal on Wednesday and for a Brexit delay yesterday. The Prime Minister will now put her Brexit deal before the Commons for a third time by the 20 March, before asking the European Council for an extension of Article 50 at their meeting on 21 March.

Dr Bernd Atenstaedt, Chairman and Chief Executive of GIUK said "We have always supported the Prime Minister who is doing her best for the country. Her Brexit deal is a good deal for business, as we have said many times and we are therefore disappointed that the Commons rejected this deal for a second time. Yet again, MPs put party politics before the interest of the country and business. We now urge the MPs to finally back the Prime Minister's deal next week. We urgently need a decision. Uncertainty continues for us and for the time being we are still preparing for a `no-deal` which none of us want."
